

Regional Futures – Collaborative Projects

1 Assess eligibility

- Are you based in regional Queensland?
- Do you have an innovative plan to support and grow your region?
- Do you have one or more partner organisations who share the same goals?
- Are you able to match grant funds with cash on a dollar-for-dollar basis?
- Can you clearly outline the problem being solved or the opportunity being leveraged?
- Do you know the economic strengths of your region?
- Are you ready to deliver the project within 60 days of being funded?
- What tangible and sustainable impact to the region(s) will be realised after the project is complete?

2 Collaboration tips

- You need a minimum of 2 organisations collaborating on the project.
- The Applicant Organisation is the one applying for the grant and leading the project.
- The Collaborative Partner Organisation is a separate organisation also supporting the project through cash.
- Both the Applicant Organisation and the Collaborative Partner Organisation must be based in a Queensland region (but it doesn't have to be the same region).
- If the Applicant Organisation and 1 Collaborative Partner Organisation are based in a Queensland region(s), any additional partners do not have to be based in a Queensland region.
- You can have more than one Collaborative Partner Organisation involved in the project.
